The official participating teams will be confirmed following FIFA's final tournament draw. However, Dallas will welcome several national teams during the group stage, followed by qualifying teams advancing through the knockout rounds.

Because the stadium hosts multiple tournament stages, visitors have an excellent chance of watching some of the world's highest-ranked national teams during the competition.

Unlike many host cities that only stage a handful of matches, Dallas offers visitors multiple opportunities to attend games throughout the tournament. Fans staying in the area for several days may be able to watch different teams across multiple stages without additional domestic travel.

How to Reach AT&T Stadium

AT&T Stadium is centrally located within the Dallas–Fort Worth metroplex, making it accessible from both major cities as well as nearby airports. Planning your transportation ahead of time is important, as match-day traffic is expected to be heavy throughout the tournament.

From Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport (DFW)

DFW Airport is the closest major airport to AT&T Stadium and serves hundreds of domestic and international flights every day.

By Car

While Dallas offers DART rail services and Trinity Railway Express connections throughout the metroplex, visitors should note that public transportation does not directly reach AT&T Stadium. Many supporters combine rail travel with ride-share services or event shuttles for the final portion of their journey.
